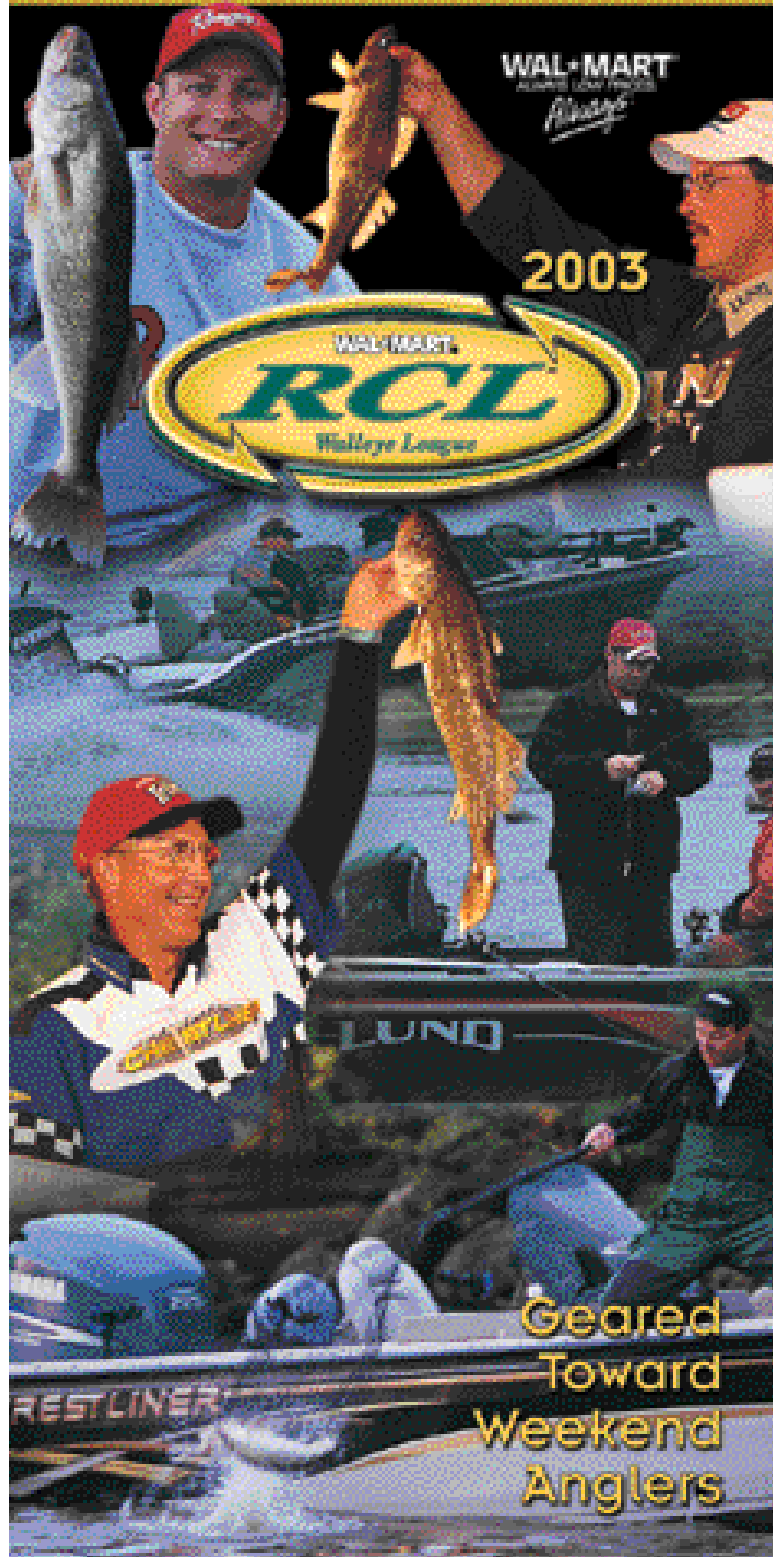

1. **RULE CHANGES** • These rules will remain unchanged during the year 2003. Interpretation of these rules will be left exclusively to the tournament director. Decisions of the tournament director are final in all matters and are not subject to appeal. Protests must be made in writing within 30 minutes of the official check-in time of the final flight of each tournament day.

2. **PARTICIPATION AND ELIGIBILITY** • Qualifying Events – It will be the responsibility of anglers to submit their application and deposits in accordance with the procedures outlined below. Participation is open only to members of FLW Outdoors who are 16 years of age or older. Any person entering a tournament under the age of majority must also have the signature of their parent or legal guardian in the provided space on the entry form. A completed entry form and the complete entry fee must be received in-house at FLW Outdoors no later than the published deadline for each tournament. FLW Outdoors will accept 150 contestants (75 boats) at each qualifying tournament. The possibility exists that over 150 contestants may fish a qualifying event. Entries received after a tournament has filled will be placed on a waiting list. Boaters may submit a \$150.00 fee (\$200.00 for a Super Tournament) for each event to hold their spot. Co-anglers may submit a \$75.00 fee (\$100.00 for a Super Tournament) for each event to hold their spot. For anglers that are Ranger, Crestliner or Lund owners, entries will be accepted to hold spots for tournaments beginning 8:00 a.m. Central time, January 27, 2003. All other entries will be accepted to hold spots for tournaments beginning 8:00 a.m. Central time, February 3, 2003. Anglers entering with a counterpart will be given priority; anglers entering all three events with a counterpart will be given top priority. All others will be confirmed in order of entry. Deposits may be made by mail, phone, fax, or online at www.flwoutdoors.com. Entry fees may be transferred or refunded if FLW Outdoors is notified by 5:00 p.m. Central time Tuesday, prior to Saturday's tournament (FLW Outdoors business hours are 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. Central Time); entry fees will not be transferred or refunded after Tuesday. There will be a \$10.00 service charge for each refund of an entry fee. Those placed on the waiting list that are not accepted into the tournament will receive a full refund after the tournament.

POINTS STANDINGS - 200 points will be awarded to the winner of each qualifying event, 199 to 2nd, 198 to 3rd, etc. Super Tournaments will award 300 points to the winner, 298 to 2nd, 296 to 3rd, etc. All anglers who receive weight credit will receive points.

WAL-MART RCL WALLEYE LEAGUE FINALS – From each division the top 25 boaters and the top 25 co-anglers from the year-end points standings will qualify for the Wal-Mart RCL Walleye League Finals. If any qualifier is unable to attend the Wal-Mart RCL Walleye League Finals, the next angler on the standings list will be eligible. Anglers who fish and qualify in more than one division will represent the division in which they placed highest.

3. **PRE-TOURNAMENT PRACTICE** • There will be no official practice period or off-limits period prior to the pre-tournament meeting. No contestant may be on tournament waters for the purpose of locating walleye or locating potential fishing waters after the pre-tournament meeting except during tournament hours. The purchasing of information or the hiring of services will not be permitted after the entry date for each event.

4. **REGISTRATION AND PRE-TOURNAMENT MEETING** • Each contestant must register in person at the designated site during the official

registration hours of 3:00-6:00 p.m. local time the day before the tournament. Contestants registering between 6:00-6:15 p.m. will pay a \$25.00 late fee, which will be donated to the FishAmerica Foundation. Contestants more than 15 minutes late will forfeit their entry fee and will not be entered in the tournament. It is mandatory that all contestants attend the pre-tournament meeting, which will be held at 6:30 p.m. local time. Being late for the pre-tournament meeting will result in a \$25.00 late fee, which will be donated to the FishAmerica Foundation. Any contestant not present for partner pairings will forfeit their entry fee and will not be entered in the tournament.

5. **PAIRINGS** • Partners will be paired by draw. All contestants must meet with their assigned partners during pairings at the pre-tournament meeting. Partners should advise each other of their respective lodging and phone numbers and establish a meeting time and place for the following morning's takeoff. The tournament director, at his sole discretion, may reassign partners prior to the morning takeoff.

6. **SAFETY** • Safe boating must be observed at all times. Each contestant is required to wear a fastened, U.S. Coast Guard-approved personal flotation device any time the main combustion engine is in operation above idle from boat check until weigh-in. All boats must be equipped with an emergency ignition shut-off device that must be securely attached to the driver's body whenever the main combustion engine is in operation above idle. We strongly recommend that each boat have a fully functional marine band base radio and adequate fixed antenna. (Marine radios will be mandatory in Wal-MartRCL Walleye League events in 2004). The use of mobile communication devices during tournament hours, such as cellular telephones, marine radios, walkie-talkies, CBs, etc., is permitted except to communicate fishing information. At the discretion of the tournament director, tournament days may be shortened or canceled due to unsafe weather or water conditions.

7. **SPORTSMANSHIP** • All contestants are required to follow high standards of sportsmanship, courtesy and conservation and to conduct themselves in a manner that will be a credit to themselves, to FLW Outdoors, FLW Outdoors sponsors, the sport of fishing and FLW Outdoors' efforts to promote the sport. Examples of conduct not complying with those standards include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Consumption and/or possession of alcoholic beverages or any kind of mind-altering substance during registration, the pre-tournament meeting or during tournament hours extending through the weigh-in procedure.
- Abuse of, or addiction to, mind-altering substances.
- Conviction of a felony within the past 36 months.
- Any other words, conduct or actions reflecting unfavorably upon efforts to promote safety, sportsmanship, fair competition and compliance with tournament rules.

In case of any conduct not complying with the standards, FLW Outdoors shall have the right to refuse any application, or to deny a confirmed application by returning the entry fee of a previously accepted application, or to disqualify a contestant.

8. **BOAT OPERATION** • Boaters will have complete control of boat operation and waters to be fished. Boaters must provide their co-angler partners with all presentation equipment such as downriggers, planer boards, side planers, rods, reels, bait, line and terminal tackle. Co-anglers are not permitted to bring any tackle into the boater's boat.

Co-anglers who share their boater partner's fishing locations with any other competitors will be disqualified, along with the person utilizing this information.

9. BOAT AND HORSEPOWER REGULATION • All boats must be a minimum of 17' in length. All boats must be equipped with either wheel or tiller steering. No other steering devices will be permitted. No barges or similar cumbersome crafts will be permitted. Each boat must have all required U.S. Coast Guard safety equipment. Boats must contain a properly aerated livewell space to maintain alive a limit catch of fish. Maximum horsepower for all outboards used in tournament competition will be 250 horsepower, not to exceed the horsepower limitations set by the U.S. Coast Guard. Each boat must have a U.S. Coast Guard horsepower rating plate attached to the boat by the manufacturer. The horsepower of the outboard engine must not exceed the rating specified on this rating plate or the 250 horsepower maximum set by FLW Outdoors. By signing the entry form, each contestant agrees to submit their boats and/or motors to an inspection by factory-trained personnel. Falsifying information on entry forms or altering the horsepower numbers on the motor or rating plate will be cause for disqualification from the tournament and may result in future ineligibility to enter FLW Outdoors tournaments. Fuel may be carried only in factory-installed fuel tanks. Additional factory-option gas tanks (for a remote engine) must be installed by a manufacturer's authorized dealer or service crew. Gas tanks must be secured or strapped. Any additional fuel used during the tournament day must be purchased from a retail facility open to the public.

10. PERMITTED FISHING METHODS • All fish must be caught in a conventional sporting manner. Live bait may be used. No more than two fishing rods per angler may be used at a time. Trolling is permitted.

11. PERMITTED FISHING LOCATIONS • Contestants may fish anywhere on tournament waters accessible by boat, except areas designated as "off-limits" or "no fishing" by local, state or federal officials or within any other competitor's first marked fishing area. A "marked fishing area" is defined as a 50-foot diameter area centered with a marker buoy. The contestant must remain within the marked area and may leave only to play and land a fish. When limited out or not fishing, the marker must be picked up. A marked area may be navigated through if it restricts or blocks access to other fishable waters. All angling must be conducted from the boat. At no time may a contestant leave the boat to land a fish or to make the boat more accessible to fishing waters. Contestants must leave and return to the official checkpoint by boat. The boat must remain in the tournament waters during the tournament day. No tournament boat may be loaded on the trailer before the weighing of fish except with the permission of the tournament director. In the event of equipment failure or emergency, there will be only two permitted methods of returning to the official check-in: (1) by both partners remaining in their boat and being towed by water, or (2) by one of the partners entering the boat of another tournament contestant and returning with their catch to the official check-in. Under these two conditions the contestants' catches may be counted without penalty (except late penalties, dead-fish penalties or any other penalties pertaining to other tournament rules). Contestants who elect to return to the official check-in by any other means than cited above will forfeit that day's catch to that point in time of the tournament day. Any contestant returning to the check-in point will be eligible to restart and resume competition under the supervision of the tournament director or his designated tournament

official. It is the sole responsibility of contestants to locate the tournament director to request a restart. If a contestant violates any part of this rule due to an emergency or for any other reason, their catch for that day will not be counted.

12. OFFICIAL CHECKPOINTS • There will be only one official checkpoint for boat check in the morning and one official checkpoint for check-in in the afternoon. Failure to go through boat check and check-out in the morning or failure to check-in at the check-in point will result in disqualification. All fishing must cease upon check-in.

13. SCORING • The combined pounds and ounces of both contestants' catch will determine scoring during the tournament. Only walleye, sauger or saugeye are accepted species. Boaters and co-anglers will fish together for the combined daily boat weight. The maximum limit will be six (6) fish per boat per day unless the state or lake limit is less than six (6), in which case the state or lake limit will prevail. The official minimum length limit will be fourteen (14) inches unless the state or lake limit is over fourteen (14) inches, in which case, the state or lake limit will prevail. Fish presented for weigh-in, which fail to measure the prescribed length limit, will be penalized at the rate of one (1) pound for each non-legal fish presented. Contestants' catches must be presented in an official weigh-in bag.

14. LIVE FISH • Every effort must be made to keep fish alive through the use of a properly aerated livewell. FLW Outdoors recommends the use of chemical additives that promote the healthy return of fish to their natural habitat where permissible. Eight (8) ounces will be deducted from the total weight for each non-releasable fish presented for weigh-in (a releasable fish must be able to swim upright in the official bump-tank).

15. LATE PENALTY • Contestants who are not at the official check-in area at the appointed time will be penalized one (1) pound per minute deducted from the total weight. Contestants more than fifteen (15) minutes late will lose credit for the day's weight.

16. DAY TWO, SUPER TOURNAMENTS AND WAL-MART RCL WALL-EYE LEAGUE FINALS • After Day 1, the field will be cut to the top 15 boaters and co-anglers. Starting positions for boaters will be determined by order of finish after Day 1. Co-anglers will be paired by random draw.

17. TIES • In case of ties, positions will be resolved by combining and dividing the awards equally among the tied contestants (this does not apply to RCL Bonus cash). Trophy positions will be determined by lottery among those tied. The tournament director may decide to break a first-place tie with a fish-off. Ties on Day 1 of Super Tournaments will be resolved by points standings. Ties on Day 2 of Super Tournaments will be resolved by Day 1 standings.

18. LOGOS • During the Wal-Mart RCL Walleye League Finals, no logos, patches, or decals other than the Wal-Mart RCL Walleye League logo or logos of the Wal-Mart RCL Walleye League sponsors may be worn or displayed during the tournament hours extending through the weigh-in. During the Wal-Mart RCL Walleye League Finals, competitors may not fish while using tobacco products.

19. INSURANCE • Liability insurance is required of all contestants in FLW Outdoors tournaments.

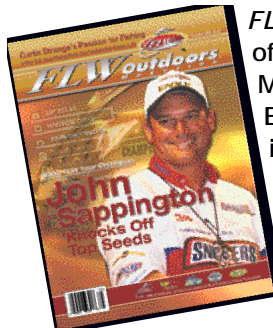
